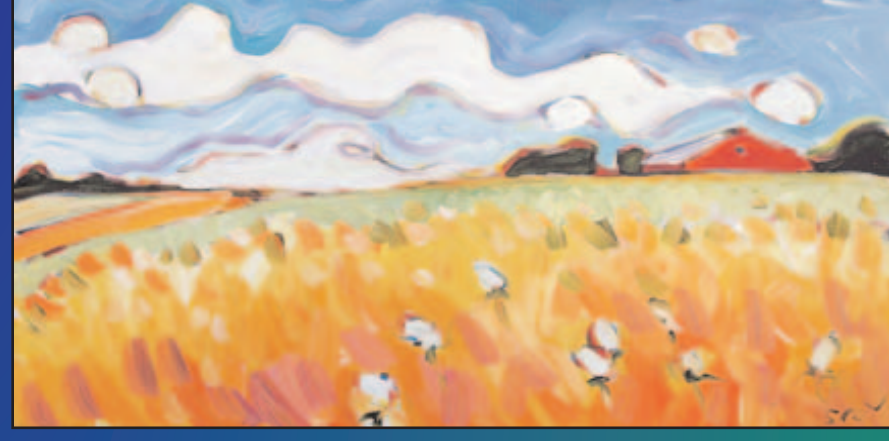
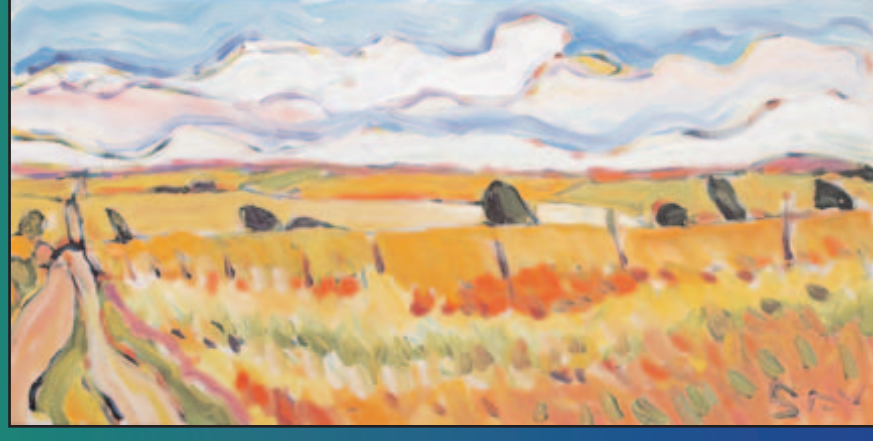
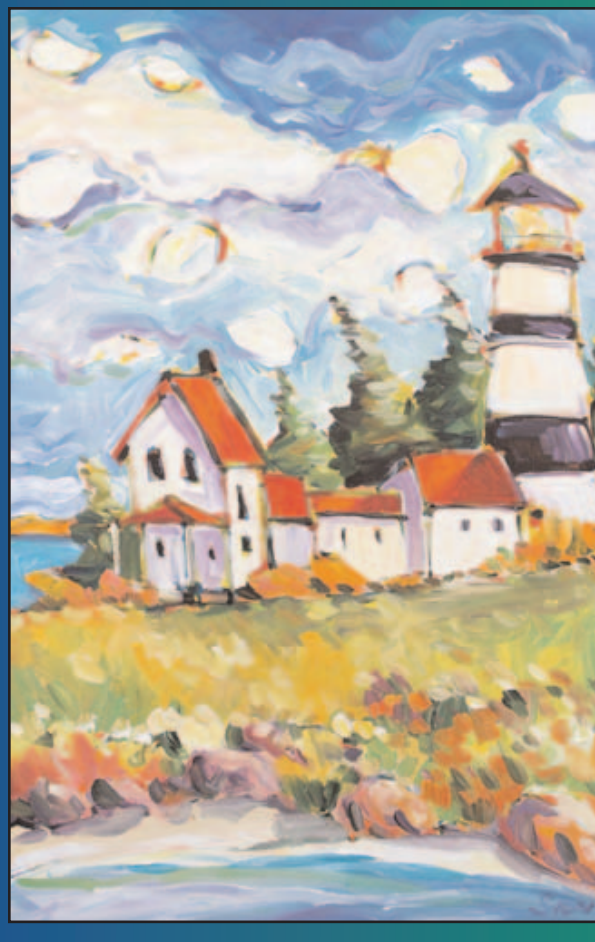
THE SCOOP
